- To increase extension activities. (Blood donation drive etc.)
- To collaborate with industries and other institutions.
- To increase the number of ICT enabled classrooms.
- To encourage the faculty for research work.
- To improve the salary and other benefits for the employees.
- To fully automate the library systems.
- To target a higher grade in NAAC 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle.
- To organize webinars.
- To conduct capacity building workshops for faculty members
- Implementation of E-Governance in various area
- To increase the number of computers and IT facilities.

## **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STRATEGIC PLANS:**

Knowing the vision and goals of the institution, priority was given to the need for starting new courses in relevance with the demand and current trends. In the year 2019-20 a UG programme in Science was introduced and in the year 2021-2022 PG programme in commerce was also introduced.
