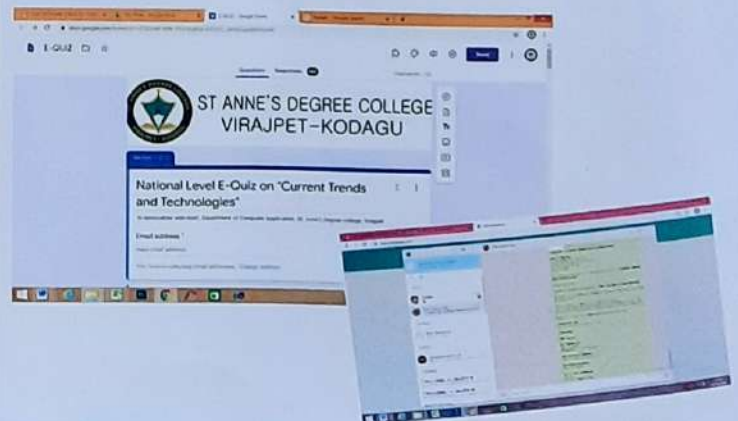

WEBINAR ON E-COMMERCE

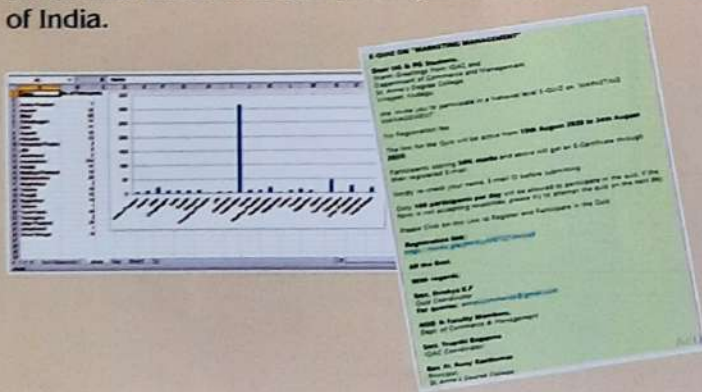

All the NSS volunteers participated enthusiastically and dedicated themselves for the service of the nation.



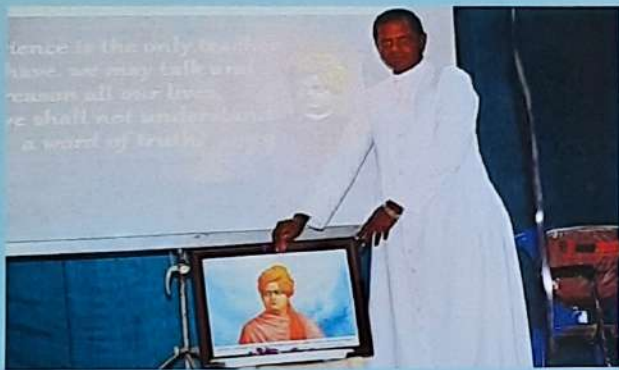
SUBHASH CHANDRA BOSE JAYANTHI

14 teams participated in this event. Each team comprised of 2 members. There were 2 rounds in total. Round 1 was Debugging and Round 2 was Coding. In Round 1, a set of 2 questions were given with some logical and syntactical errors in C Programming. Total points were evaluated upon the correctness of the given programs. Round 2 was program development and execution on System. In this round, a set of 2 questions were given to each team. Output screenshots was given to the participants. They were asked to solve the questions in C language. Points were awarded for solving each question as per the given input and output pattern.

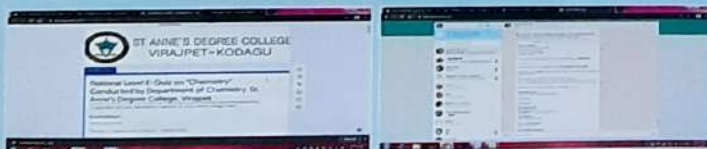

CULTURAL CLUB SOLO SINGING

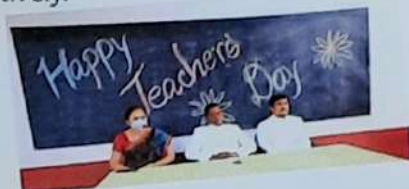
